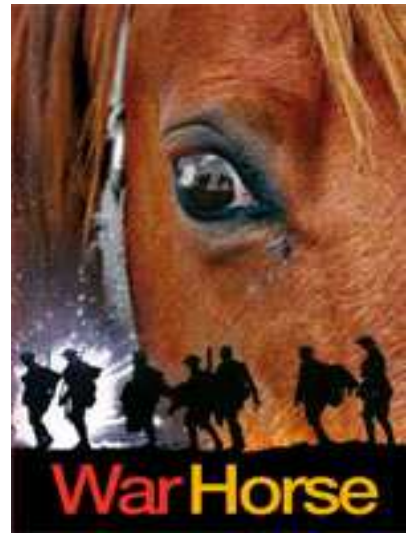

**War Horse and Natural History Museum**

We will also provide a mid morning snack. Please could all girls bringing their food from home make sure that they have enough to keep them going during the day. All girls should bring a backpack for their packed lunch. We will eat at about 12:30 at the Natural History Museum and then again on the coach on the way home at about 6:00. Please provide the girls with a couple of drinks.

The girls will be required to wear school uniform including The Manor green coat so they can be easily identified. The girls can wear a hat, scarf and gloves but should look after these and not leave them under their seats!

Programmes for *War Horse* are available at £4:00 and an interval ice cream is £3:20. We are happy for the girls to bring the correct amount of money but there will not be time to visit any other shops and I would prefer that the girls did not eat sweets during the show.

The bus will be returning to school at approximately 8.00pm. Please be aware that the bus company will insist that the children wear the safety restraints provided which could either be seat belts or lap belts depending on the individual coach used.
