Dear Parents

Many thanks for your generosity on Wednesday this week when we had a home clothes day to raise money for the NSPCC and ChildLine. We are thrilled as we raised £463.38.

As many of you will remember, at this time of year the children in Years 3 and 4 hold their annual cake sale to coincide with **UNICEF Day for Change 2012** and this year it takes place on **Friday 3rd February**. We are conscious of the fact that we are having two charity events in quick succession for external reasons and we ask you for your kind forbearance!

Day for Change is UNICEF's annual fundraising and activities day for UK schools. This is a day when children in the UK help other children in the world who are not as fortunate as they are. This year they will be raising money to promote development through sport for children in Uganda.

At The Manor the money is traditionally raised in two ways. Children may wear home clothes to school and make a voluntary contribution to the fund (we recommend £1 but it can be as little or as much as you are happy to contribute). The money raised will be added to that collected from the sale of cakes baked by the girls in Years 3 and 4 which will be sold on the same day. Small cakes will be available for the children to purchase for 25p each and children are allowed to buy 4 cakes each.

We would ask that the children bring their money in a named purse on that morning.
