Dear Parents

On Friday 4th February the school will be taking part in *Day for Change*, UNICEF's annual fundraising and activities day for UK schools. This is a day when children in the UK help other children in the world who are not as fortunate as they are. Last year the children at The Manor raised £728.65 to help children in Mozambique. This year they will be raising money to help children in Guyana. In total last year UNICEF raised nearly £300,000. With your help, we hope to help UNICEF do even better this year!

At The Manor the money is traditionally raised in two ways. For a donation of £1.00 the children may come to school in home clothes. The money raised will be added to that collected from the sale of cakes baked by the girls in Years 3 and 4 which will be sold on the same day. Small cakes will be available for the children to purchase for 20p each and children are allowed to buy 5 cakes each.

Proceeds from both events will support UNICEF's campaign to promote health and education for children in Guyana, a country that is currently suffering badly from the effects of climate change.

We would ask that the children bring the £2.00 in a named purse on that morning.
