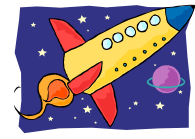

School Fete



Dear Parents

The Year 6s are very much looking forward to seeing all of the children and parents and friends at the School Fete on Wednesday 29th June.

There will be a lot of different activities and refreshments for everyone to enjoy and we hope to raise as much money as possible at the same time for our three charities. As the fete is now less than two weeks away I would like to take the opportunity to give a few reminders:

1. Raffle ticket stubs need to be returned to the school office by Monday 27th June. Extra tickets will be available for purchase during the fete. I would be grateful if you would return any unsold tickets to the school so that we can sell them at the fete.
2. Please can people who are donating **cakes or other produce** bring them to the dining room on the morning of the fete - i.e. **Wednesday 29th June**. It is vital that all products and cakes are nut free as we do have children with nut allergies at the school.
3. Donations of books, DVDs, puzzles, toys and items for the tombola and raffle can be brought to my office anytime between now and the day of the fete.
4. Children are invited to arrive in school on the morning of the fete in fancy dress, fitting in with a Space theme (including aliens!) if they wish. Alternatively, they can come to school in home clothes that morning. We have some very colourful flashing Space Bug Head Boppers for sale at £2.50 each which can be purchased at any time from the School Office or from Mrs Stokes, or at the fete. They can be worn with or without fancy dress and I am sure will create a great sense of fun on the day. All profit from the sale of the head boppers will be shared equally between the three charities.
5. **Children will be free to be collected from their form rooms at 12:00 noon for their picnic lunch.** (If it is wet the picnic lunches will be eaten in some of the classrooms).
6. As pointed out in a previous letter the children need to be supervised at all times during the afternoon by a parent or nominated responsible adult.
7. PLEASE provide your child with small change (no notes) for the fete, in a **named purse**.

We are sure the fete will be a very enjoyable occasion for all and we look forward to seeing you all there.
