Dear Parents,

Early Registration with Boarding Schools and Mr Heyworth's School Visits

Parents who may be considering boarding education for their children need to note that the occasional boarding school gets so popular that it closes its lists early - for example, Wycombe Abbey has received so many registrations for September 2012 entry that it closed its lists in March 2011. Girls' boarding schools advise parents to visit them while the child is in Year 4 or at the start of Year 5, to be safe.

Boys' schools can be even earlier (Radley College accepts registrations from birth and fills its lists quickly). Other schools such as Marlborough College do not accept registrations before the child is 9 but one would be advised not to leave registration much later than that.

Please feel free to contact me for more detailed advice over particular schools. This term I am due to visit Wycombe Abbey, Leckford Place, Headington, Tudor Hall, Oxford High and The Dragon. Please let me know if there are any particular schools you would like me to visit.
