## Clothes and Equipment List

**Please wear for the journey:**

- Trousers
- Layered tops, including warm fleece (it will be cold at our early morning start)
- Trainers

**B**

**Please pack in a small suitcase or soft bag (must have wheels):**

**N.B. THIS IS NOT ACCESSIBLE DURING THE JOURNEY**

- 4 sets of casual clothes, including T-shirt type tops\*.
- Trousers, shorts\*, skirt/dress\* (optional), sweatshirts/ Summer pullovers
- 4 pairs knickers and socks
- 1 extra fleece/warm top
- 1 polo type shirt with collar and short sleeves (sun protection)
- 1 spare pair sensible shoes
- 1 pair pyjamas
- 2 swimming costumes (**not bikinis**, school swimsuit will do)
- 1 extra T-shirt for beach
- 1 pair beach shoes, Crocs, jellies or surf shoes
- 2 towels
- 1 plastic bag for wet clothes
- 1 plastic bag for dirty clothes
- Small torch
- Inexpensive kite for beach (optional)
