## **Class One – starting at 9.00am**

This class is aimed at riders competing on the lead rein, or heavily assisted in the arena. Riders entering Class One are not permitted to ride in any other class on the day.

**Dressage** - Pony Club Walk and Trot Test D Level 1

(This test is available to download from the Pony Club website at [www.pcuk.org](http://www.pcuk.org))

**Jumping** – Very low jumps.

## **Class Two**

Riders may be assisted but not lead. Combinations entering Class Two are not permitted to ride in any other class on the day.

**Dressage** – Walk and Trot BD Introductory Test A(2008)

**Jumping** - Jumps Maximum height 1'0".

## **Class Three**

**Dressage** – Prelim 4 (2002)

**Jumping** – Jumps maximum height 1'6".

## **Class Four**

**Dressage** - Prelim 14 (2006)

**Jumping** - Jumps maximum height 2.0".

### **Rules of the competition**

1. Each school may enter one team per class, comprising a maximum of 5 riders per team.
2. Points will be awarded to tenth place (10 points for first place down to 1 point for tenth place). The school accumulating the most points across the three classes will be declared the winner, and presented with The Manor Riders Cup, to retain for one year.
3. Rosettes will be awarded to sixth place in each class.
4. A school may enter more than five riders per class, but the "team" must be nominated before the start. Additional riders may compete as individuals and can still be placed, but no points will be awarded to their school. In the case that non-team riders are placed in the top ten, the points will be awarded down the placings as required.
5. No horse/pony may compete in more than two classes.
6. Riders failing to report to the show jumping steward within 20 minutes after their allotted dressage time will be disqualified.
7. There will be clear round jumping throughout the day at £3.00 per round. No rider will be permitted to jump the course as a clear round until after he/she has completed the show jumping round as part of the class.
8. If classes do not fill, there will be limited availability for dressage only competitors. Anyone interested in entering the dressage section only, please contact the show secretary on or after the closing date to check availability.

11. There will be a prize for the best turned out combination in each class.
12. There will be a special rosette for the highest placed Manor rider in each class.

## HEALTH AND SAFETY

The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the official stewards. If you come to the event on your own, please notify the organisers on arrival.

## RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Events and competitions are unaffiliated unless stated otherwise. However, they will be run in accordance with the appropriate discipline rule books and in addition the rules set out below.
2. The organisers and landowners accept no responsibility for any loss or damage to any person, animal, vehicle or property whatsoever – however caused. Owners/riders enter entirely at their own risk and it is a condition of entry that no liability of any kind attaches itself to the organisers, judges or landowner of the show in any respect whatsoever.
3. Cheques should be made payable to **The Manor Preparatory School**.
4. Correct riding attire must be worn – it is the rider's responsibility to ensure this rule is observed.
5. Correctly fitting headgear and boots with heels must be worn by anyone mounted on the showground. Headgear must conform to the current BHS safety standards and must be either PAS 015 or BSEN 1384 standard or be prefixed with AST or SEI and must have a three point harness. Spot checks may be carried out. Non compliance will result in elimination. This rule takes precedent over rules on headgear/footwear contained in any Rules of Affiliated bodies.
6. Back protectors are recommended for show jumping and compulsory for cross country.
7. The judge's and/or organiser's decision is final
8. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry without giving a reason and will return the entry fee accompanying such entry.
9. The judges reserve the right to eliminate any unfit or unsound horse/pony. Any person, in the opinion of an event official, seen ill treating a horse/pony will be required to leave the showground immediately and partake in no further competitions at that event regardless of any entry fee being paid.
10. Entry fees will only be refunded on the production of a medical or veterinary certificate.
11. Horse/Ponies are not to be left unattended when tied up to trailers or lorries in the car park.
12. Children must be properly supervised at all times.
13. Please do not leave any rubbish, droppings etc. on the showground.
14. Failure to ring for times (when this is a requirement of the entry) will constitute a withdrawal.
15. If dogs are permitted on the showground, they must be kept on a lead
