

# Nursery Uniform List 2010/11

Please make sure that all items of school uniform are clearly named. Please place an individual label in the collar or waistband of each item of clothing.

Hair should be kept tidy and off the face, with the use, where necessary of hair accessories in school colours (green and pink), as well as brown and black. For safety reasons we do not permit comb clips; nor are novelty hair ties appropriate for school uniform. School hair bands and scrunchies are available to buy from the School Shop.

<b>PE</b> Velcro trainers White Polo shirt Track suit top (sweatshirt with Manor logo) - <i>can be worn as an alternative to the Winter uniform</i> Green jogging bottoms - <i>can be worn as an alternative to the Winter uniform</i> Green cycle shorts (girls) and green shorts (boys) - <i>can be worn as an alternative to the Summer uniform with a white polo shirt</i>
