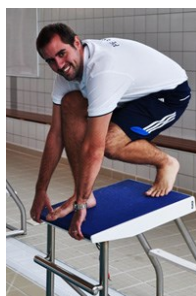

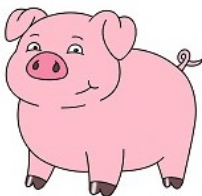

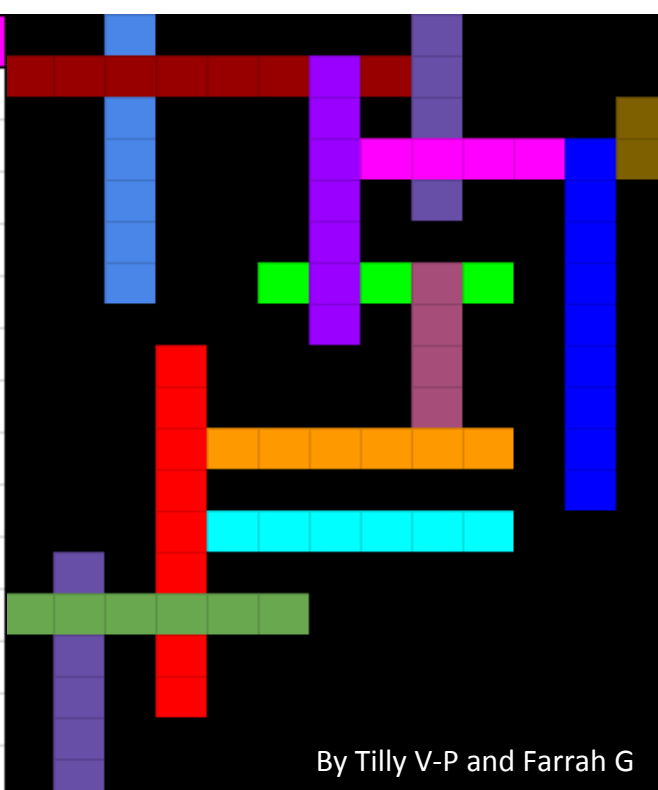

One day we went down to London to see a play.

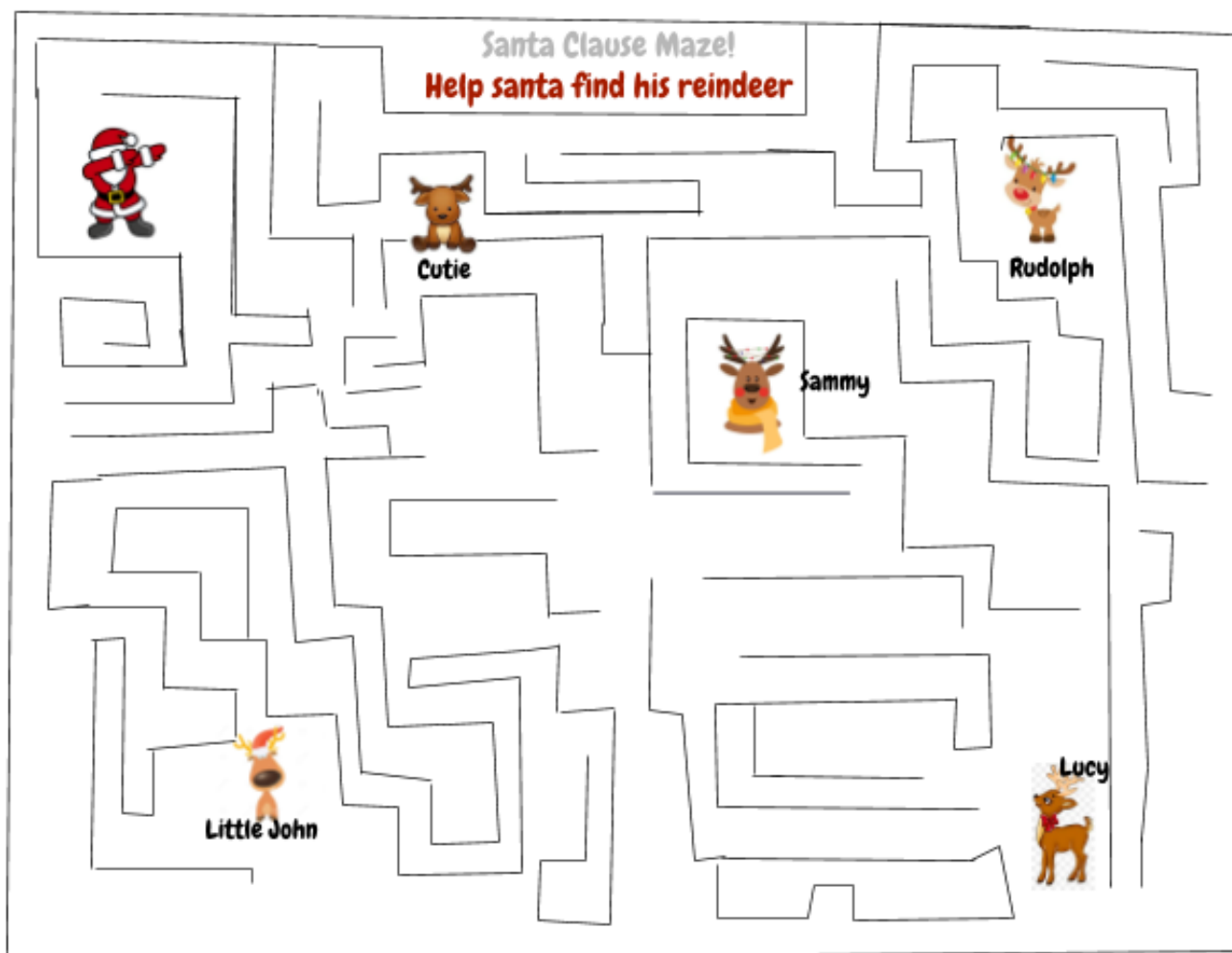
But one thing we didn't know was that we forgot the keys...!

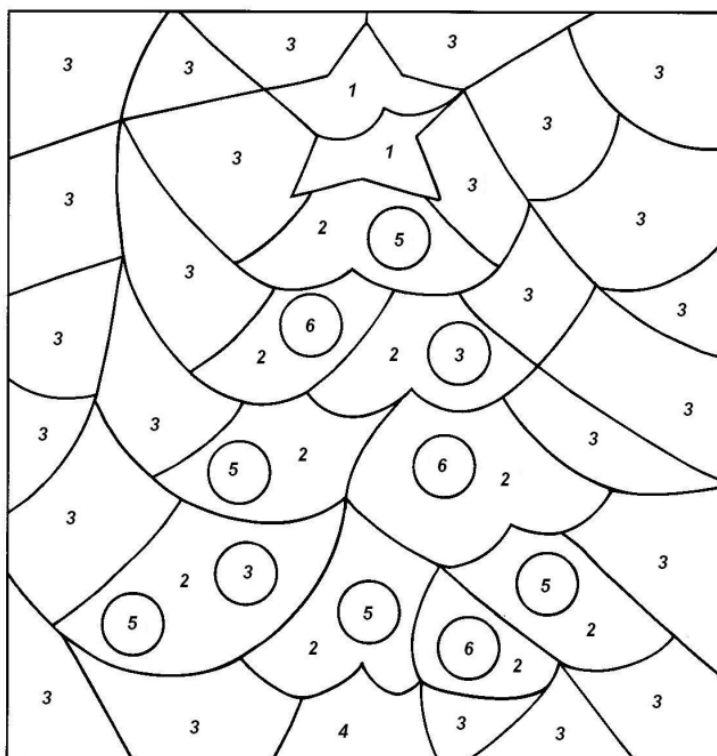

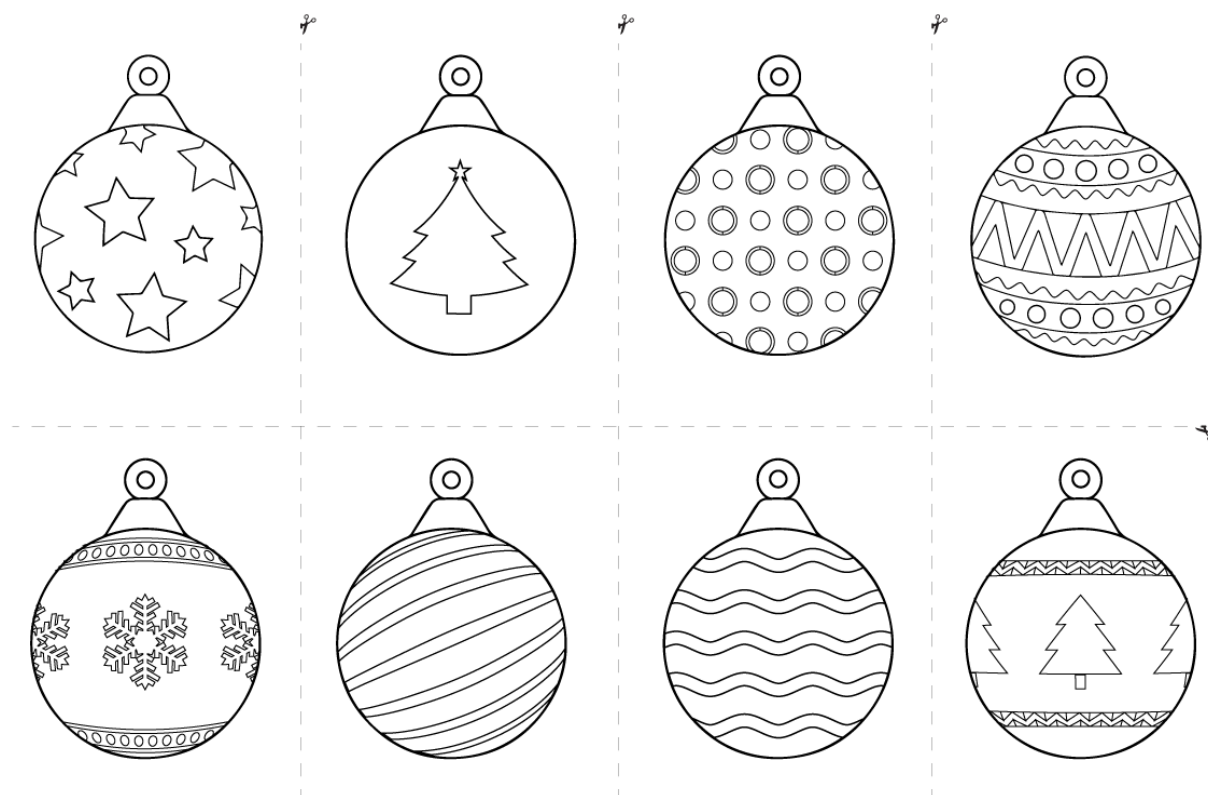

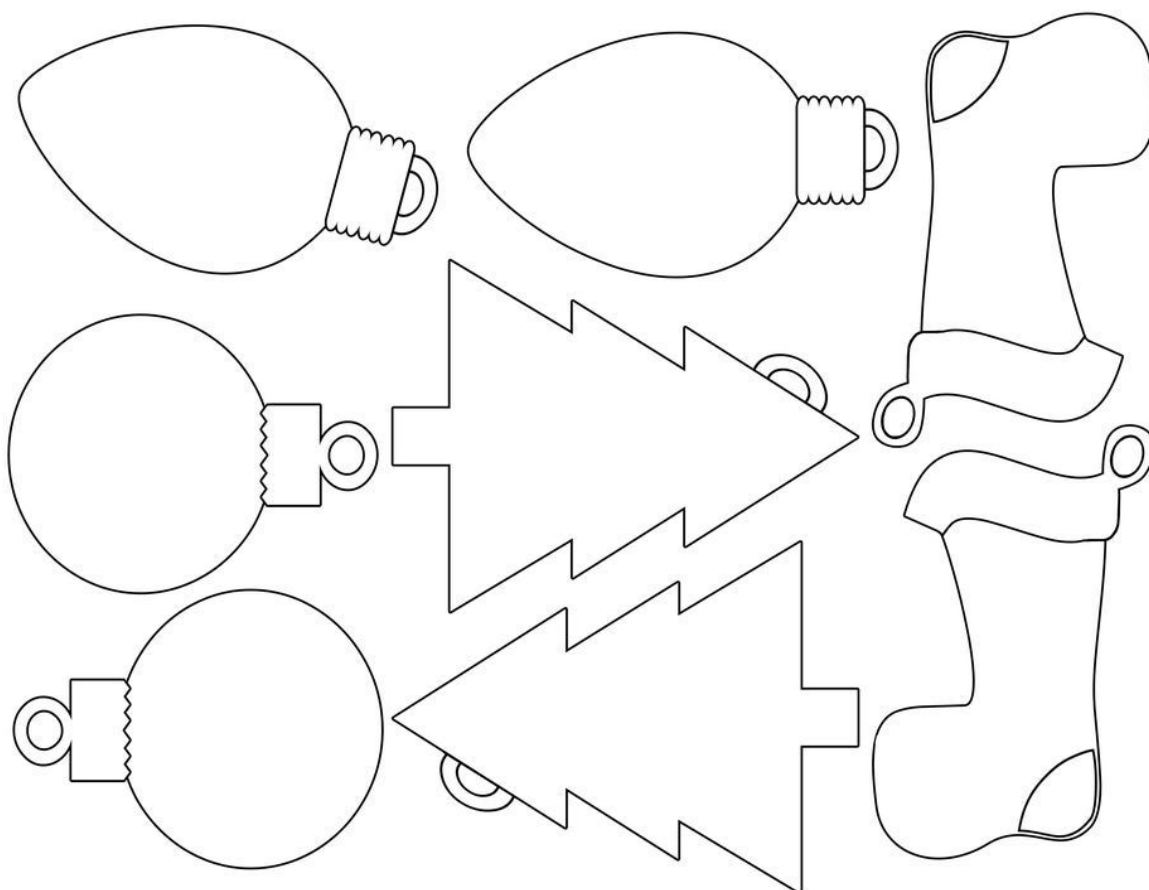
