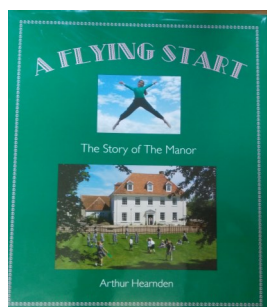

Tilly Y5: It is very fun and you get to do whatever you want!

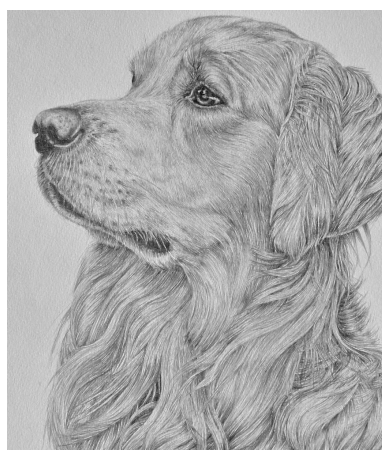
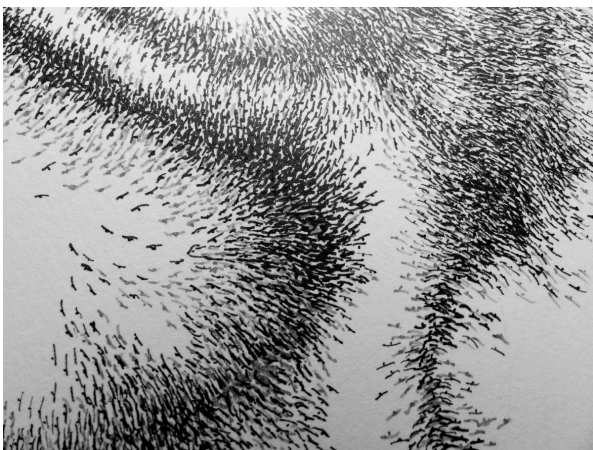
Not literally anything you want... it has to be to do with the topic you are doing at the moment!

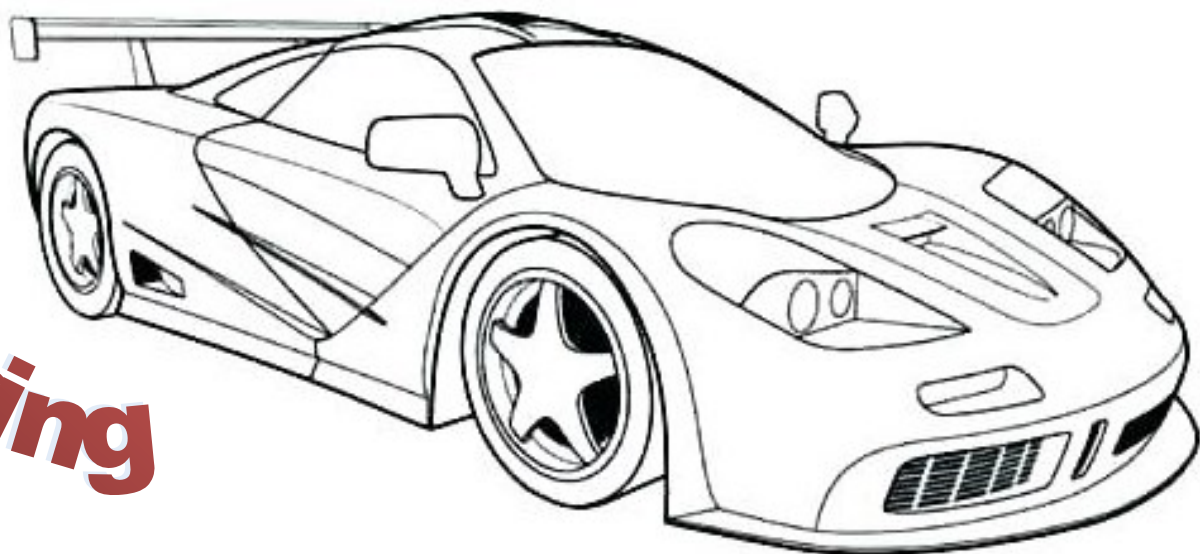
