## **Reading Morning**

After the success of our Maths Curriculum Morning last term, we warmly welcome you to our Reading Morning which is being held on Thursday 10 October from 9:00am until 10:00am. This will give you the opportunity to see the range of reading opportunities from Pre-Nursery to Year 2 at The Manor.

The morning will begin with a brief talk, where we will provide an overview of reading at The Manor, along with strategies to support your child at home.
