## Ufton Court: 'Life as a Celt' Thursday 10 October 2019

Linked to our Year 3 History topic this term, we will be visiting Ufton Court near Reading, on Thursday 10 October. We are looking forward to this trip which offers the children experiences of Celtic life through a variety of practical workshops.

We will depart at 9:00am, returning to school before 3:45pm. Homework Club, Extended Day and After School Clubs will run as usual.

The school will provide all food for this trip. This includes a morning snack and packed lunch. Before the trip, the children will have the opportunity to choose their preferred option for lunch. Special dietary requirements will be catered for.

Please may the children wear school uniform and bring a water bottle, school coat and a small rucksack.

The children will be offered face paint (either on face or hands) as part of their immersion into Celtic life! We will assume that all children can participate in this unless we are informed separately of any skin sensitivities. If your child **should not** be offered face/hand paint, please inform Mrs Judy Ramm, the School Nurse (<a href="mailto:schoolnurse@manorprep.org">schoolnurse@manorprep.org</a> or 01235 858473), by Friday 4 October so that school records can be updated and lists prepared for teachers for the trip where necessary - thank you. The children will arrive home wearing their face paint so expect excited recollections of the day!

Please be aware that the bus company will insist that the children wear the safety restraints provided which could either be seat belts or lap belts depending on the individual coach used.

Please also be aware that if you have declared your child to have asthma/an allergy requiring an adrenaline auto-injector (AAI) on their school medical form and they have been prescribed an inhaler/AAI, your child will not be allowed to leave the school site without their device. Thank you for your co-operation.

We hope the children will enjoy exploring 'Life as a Celt' and build on this experience back in the classroom.
