The Oxford Music Festival will take place at Rye St Antony School, Pullen's Lane OX3 7SA, and our class will be in Rendall Hall. Please use the Franklin Road entrance to the school off Headley Way. There will be some parking available in the school grounds. Overflow parking is available on the Oxford Brookes Headington Hill Campus. The entrance is at the junction of Pullen's Lane and Headington Road. If travelling by car allow ample time as there might not be available parking on site.

The timings for the morning are as follows:

9:15am – meet in the foyer of Rye St Antony School (the main entrance)

9:25 – 9:55am – children warm-up with Miss Pearmain and Mrs Haines

9:55am – performance in Rendall Hall. Parents are very welcome to watch

11:45am (approx.) – class finishes. Children collected by parents from foyer

Tickets will be available on the door and are £3 for adults and £2.50 for children and concessions. Competitors and children under 6 years are admitted free.

Please could you ensure that your child is smartly dressed in their school uniform (including their school jumper and a clean white shirt).
