Manorisms - But not as we know it!

We have thought long and hard about whether to produce Manorisms this year and on reflection we have decided not to proceed.

There are a number of reasons for this but the prevailing one is that since we have all been at home for many weeks, this publication will not accurately reflect your child's Manor experience. Typical Manor life is full of exciting trips, visitors, Sports Days, House events, Art Exhibitions, Assemblies, Plays, Charity efforts, French Breakfasts, Public Speaking competitions, Sporting fixtures, Forest School, Clubs and so much more but this year the children have been denied many of these opportunities.

However, we appreciate that our Year 6's, for whom leaving The Manor after lockdown is arguably the hardest, will not therefore have their final Manorisms.

So we have arranged a compromise this year as follows:
