Weekly Update

Firstly, I hope that you all had a lovely half term break and enjoyed the wonderful weather that we were so fortunate to have. I am pleased to report that as I write this we seem to be having a more British Summer!

This week has seen the partial re-opening of school as we welcomed back on site children and their teachers in Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 6, along with our Critical Worker children. It has been so exciting to have some children back in school but there is also a tinge of sadness that we are not all here together. I am extremely proud of all of the children who continue to learn remotely and the staff who are working tirelessly to facilitate this. This whole process has reminded me of what a remarkable team effort this has been between children, parents and staff and I remain incredibly grateful to everyone for their ongoing support.

We continue to follow closely, latest developments around the wider opening of educational settings and we are confident that we will be fully prepared for the next phase.

the top of your school. It looks increasingly unlikely that we will be able to celebrate properly at the end of this term but we are exploring the possibility of a reunion next term and we aim to give more detail in next week's mailing.
