


















BREAKING NEWS! We follow the story as Dan Biggar comes to Manor Prep

Eve's and Lola's kitchen hour! We are going to show you one of our favourite recipes.

Let's get started!

Sugar cookies

100g unsalted butter, softened

- 100g caster sugar
- 2 eggs
- 1tsp vanilla extract
- 30g cornflour
- 300g plain flour



Method

STEP 1

Beat the butter and sugar with an electric whisk for 4 mins until light and fluffy. Beat in the eggs, one at a time, then add the vanilla. Whisk in the cornflour and plain flour until the mixture comes together into a dough. Put the dough between two pieces of baking parchment, and roll out to a 6mm thickness using a rolling pin. Chill for 30 mins.


STEP 2

Heat the oven to 200C/180C fan/gas 6. Peel the top layer of parchment off the dough and stamp out circles using a 6cm round cutter (or the shape of your choice). Re-roll any offcuts and continue stamping out rounds until all the dough is used. Transfer the cookies to a second large baking sheet lined with baking parchment, spacing them 2cm apart (you may need two sheets). Bake for 7-10 mins. Leave to cool on the sheet for 15 mins, then transfer to a wire rack to cool completely.

Will keep in an airtight container for one week.
