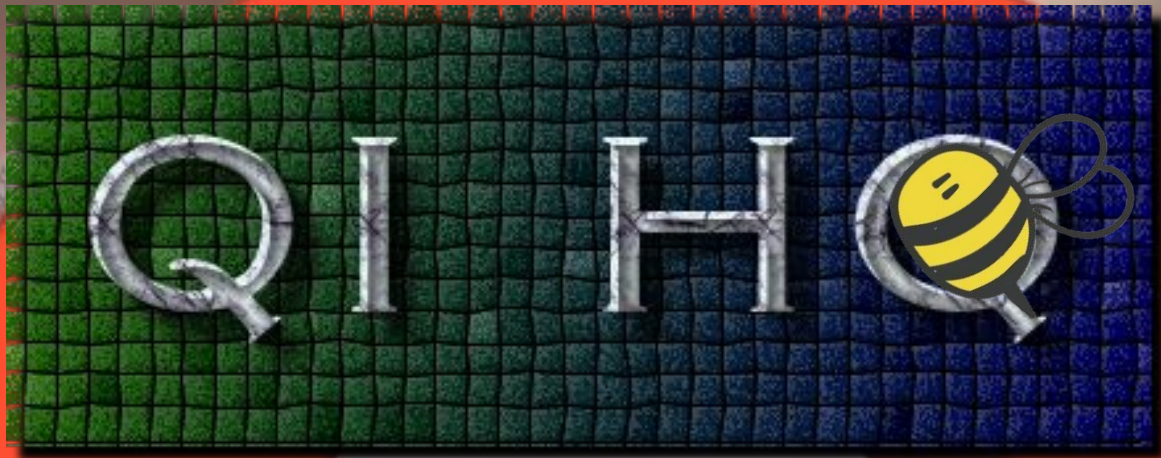
Fudge & Sprinkles Recipe
