Play with mud to create a series of miniature makes from Jewellery to tea sets. Work on your creative and fine motor skills. All pieces will be glazed and fired.

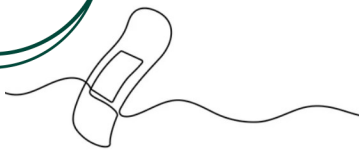

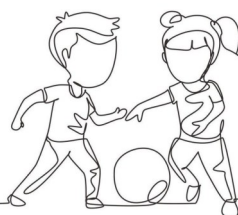

Pen Pals

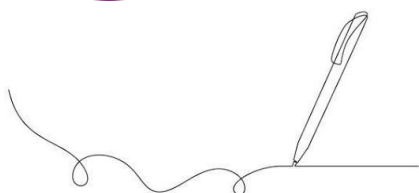

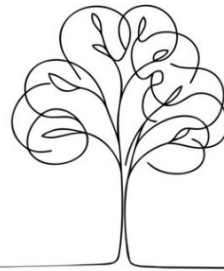
